



Episode 4: Learn from Family

5 minute challenge—**Talk to family to find out more information!**

Steps:

1. Pick a method to contact your family:
 - Email—Better to articulate your question, but slower response.
 - Phone or visit—Best way to ask follow-up questions and get more information.
 - Social Network—Easy to get information from extended family.

2. Prepare questions you want to ask.

3. Speak with your relative and write down what you learn.

Social Network:

Online tool used to communicate with online communities.

Helpful hints:

Start by talking with someone you are close to, like a parent or a sibling.

Ask open-ended questions. Prepare questions that will be answered with dates, locations, names, and specific events.

Write it all down!

Ask for copies of any records your family may have.
