Practice Exercises

Do the following:

1. In the Help Center, find the document titled “What are Church policies about temple ordinances and the new FamilySearch?”
 2. Find an answer in the temple policy document for the following:
 - a. How do I seal myself and other living siblings to our deceased parents?
 - b. I would like to do the work for all of the descendants of one of my ancestors. Is that okay?
 - c. I don’t know the birth or death dates and places of a person, but I do know the name and the parents’ names. Can I do the temple work?
 - d. I found new information about an ancestor that was not correct when the ordinances were done. Should I redo the ordinances?
 - e. I did the temple ordinances for my ancestor, but different dates are listed under temple ordinances. Why?
 3. The next time you help a member with family history, use the Ask, Find, Teach process.
 4. Teach one member how to find a temple policy answer in the Help Center.
