Menu Bar

Access programs, students, stakes, and wards for your current assignment.

Create Activities

Record tasks, phone conversations, emails, and appointments.

Program Admin

Find quick links to easily contact local program administrators.

Program Statistics

See current and next year's statistics at a glance.

Stake and Ward Views

Easily see seminary and institute status for all your stakes and wards.

Search

Search by name for any student in the current view. Use an asterisk (*) before or after your entry if you do not know the full name.

7 Student Views

Open 10+ different views to see a list of exactly the students you are looking for. Each view can also be printed or downloaded in a variety of formats.

Sort by Column



Each column is easily sortable, just like in an Excel document.

Student Information

Double-click on each student's name to get more details, including general, membership, contact, and enrollment information.

RECRUITMENT TRACKING FEATURE
